The Representative is elected to serve for a one year period, and may stand for re-election

What will I do?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be receptive to the wishes and needs of club members throughout the County • Represent those wishes and needs when it diverges from the direction being taken by the Bowls Surrey Board • Attend County Roadshows and Area/Zone meetings to hear the voice of the membership • Help and assist in the Retention processes of Clubs • Attend the Bowls England AGM and Regional Meetings
How much time will I need to give?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 hours per month • attendance at all Bowls Surrey meetings (4 per year)
What do I need to do this role?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confident and good at communicating, • To be approachable and friendly, • Diplomatic and discreet, • Well-organised.
What are the benefits and how will you support me?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will gain the satisfaction of making a vital difference to the County and the players within it. • The Bowls Surrey will reimburse any <u>agreed</u> expenses that you incur. • The Bowls Surrey will provide any necessary training and support as required.
